AGM

Our annual AGM was held on October 16th in Le Bastion with 59 members attending. Robert Brereton, President, summarised our varied activities for the year, some of which are described in this Entre Nous. We continue to be in a healthy financial position only falling short of our projected budget for 2014-2015 by 40 euros!

Robert and John Kuppens described the Committee's concern that to achieve our objectives we need additional members serving on the committee. We also need to spread the load by establishing a well organised support group of members we can call upon for help with activities and events. A joint presidency was proposed (shared between Robert and John) and was agreed by members. Alan Reeves (Treasurer) and Jenny West (Secretary) were reelected. Paul Cope (Membership Secretary) and Gwyneth Green (Group Co-ordinator) will continue in their posts. Christine Dumaux will step down as language co-ordinator – a time consuming task which she has lead for three years. We now have a vacancy for Vice President and 4 new nominations for the committee. Robert thanked the committee and volunteers for their help over the year. The meeting was followed by a very jolly social evening.

Spring Concerts



One of ACIP's initials is C for culturel. To achieve this aim we are a partner of Arcades who put on regular concerts. We Also completed our first series of three classical concerts in Audrix (with lunch), Cadouin and Le Bugue this Spring. And what a great success they were. The object of the exercise was to bring top quality artists to play in our area at an accessible price, whilst at the same time raising ACIP's cultural profile with the public and with the Mairies of the local communes involved. We certainly achieved this. The internationally acclaimed musicians and singers who performed offered a wonderfully exciting and varied programme from generally lesser known composers. They were supported by Vox Vesunna and our very own Chrissie Anderson. Members of ACIP and La Tulipe, music lovers from the area and even tourists passing by attended. We

were joined by the Conseille Generale, as well as the relevant commune's maire and/or maire-adjointes from whom we received unreserved acclaim. We enjoyed excellent write ups in the Sud-Ouest, and praise and thanks from the Maires of Le Bugue and Audrix.





As you will imagine, a venture such as this was a huge undertaking - 6 months focussed work by John Kuppens, our past Vice-President, helped by a small team of ACIP volunteers in the final weeks. Many thanks go to John and to everyone who helped to make the concerts such a success.


