

6	Membership Report	Julie was happy to report that we now have 331 members. We have 15 nationalities in our wider membership, of which approximately 7 170 are British, 62 French, 29 Dutch and 25 Americans as well as a wide variety of different nationalities making the numbers up to 331. Some members have expressed a view that ACIP is perceived as a British Club. Whilst acknowledging that the majority of our membership speak English either as a first or second language, ACIP is and will always be welcoming to all nationalities and our website and correspondence is normally communicated in 3 languages to cater for our wider membership. Having taken over the language class coordination, Jonathan suggested we send out an email to the whole membership to ask who might wish to start French lessons in September, which was agreed by the Committee. He currently knows of 10 people who have expressed a wish to start in September so felt it was likely we would need to start a third beginner's class.
